

Fees and Payments

- There is a wedding fee of \$300.00 for **members** plus a refundable deposit of \$200.00 due at the time of scheduling.
- There is a wedding fee of \$400.00 for **non-members** plus a refundable deposit of \$200.00 due at the time of scheduling.
 - The deposit is due at the time your wedding is scheduled on the church calendar. This deposit will be refunded one week following your wedding upon satisfactory building inspection. Any damages to church property will be paid out of the deposit and more will be charged if necessary.
 - The wedding fee is due at the time of rehearsal.

This fee includes:

- use of sanctuary, lobby, restrooms, two classrooms to be used as dressing rooms on day of ceremony, and kitchenette use for bridal party snacks (no cooking or food preparation is allowed).
- use of the facility for the rehearsal
- marriage preparation class material
- wedding coordinator
- sound and light technician
- wedding custodian, if custodians need to spend more than 4 hours cleaning, amount will be deducted from the deposit

This fee does not include:

- remuneration for the pastor
- services of a tech team projectionist
- church organist:
 - the wedding party and the organist come to an agreement, based on rehearsal time, learning specific music, time involved, etc...
 - if the Bethany Church organist is not available and a guest organist is used, he/she must meet and consult with the Bethany Church organist at least 2 weeks prior to the wedding.
- any room or facility not specifically listed above including the nursery*
- any damage or excess clean-up caused by the wedding party or guests
- any musicians/soloists and the wedding party come to an agreement, based on rehearsal time, learning specific music, time involved, etc...
- wedding bulletins

* If the bride wishes to use the nursery, an additional fee of \$50.00 will be added to the total fee.

Bethany United Methodist Church (BUMC) reserves the right to deviate from these guidelines and fees if BUMC feels your ceremony exceeds/differs what we consider to be a standard wedding.
